CELEBRITY JAM SESSION

The North Wales Jazz Quartet will be playing some classic standards and opening the floor to a wide variety of sitters-in, typically including horns, vocalists and rhythm section instruments. Led by special guest **LIAM BYRNE** (sax), the jam, at **8.30pm**, will be preceded at **7pm** by an optional **JAZZ WORKSHOP** for all instruments. To sit in at the jam session is **£5**, and admission to the workshop, **£3**. Participation in either event is free to those aged 25 and under (and their parents).

NEIL YATES SEXTET PLAYS THE MUSIC OF JIMMY HEATH

This outstanding sextet, which debuted at the 2019 Llandudno Jazz Festival featuring arrangements by Liam Byrne, takes inspiration from the pen of legendary saxophonist Jimmy Heath and a selection of classic albums including Playboys (1956) by Chet Baker & Art Pepper, as well as Triple Threat (1962) and On The Trail (1964) recorded by Jimmy Heath himself.

Delivering a varied programme of some choice Heath numbers interspersed with arrangements by Art Blakey, Freddie Hubbard etc, the sextet promises something for everybody, and with a front line comprised of **NEIL YATES** (trumpet), **DEAN MASSER** (alto sax) and **MIKE HOPE** (tenor sax), plus **RICHARD WETHERALL** (keyboards), **ED HARRISON** (double bass) and **GAZ HUGHES** (drums), it's hard to think of a better band to round off the current season of concerts in Llay.
